Public Comment:

There are in-person and remote options for members of the public who would like to participate in LURA meetings.

1. In-Person:

General Public Comment:

- Members of the public can speak to any item that is NOT an ordinance on the regular agenda.
- Individuals who wish to speak are asked to <u>fill out a card provided</u> in Chambers and give this to
 the City Clerk. The Chair will call people up to comment in the order the cards were received.
 Cards are only required for the general public comment portion of the meeting. Each person
 will have three minutes to speak. Public comment is limited to residents of Larimer County, and
 individuals who own property or have business interests in the City.

 Individuals who wish to speak in-person but did not fill out a card <u>may</u> have a chance to comment once all in-person and online speakers who have registered are called on, if there is any time remaining. General Public Comment is limited to 60-minutes.

Regular Agenda Items:

- No cards are required for individuals wanting to provide public comment on items included on the Regular Agenda.
- If an individual comments on a Resolution item shown on the Regular Agenda during General Public Comment, no additional comment can be given once the item comes up for discussion on the Regular Agenda.
- Once a motion is made on an item shown on the Regular Agenda, the Chair will ask for public comment. The Chair will invite speakers to comment at that time. In-person comment will occur first, followed by online public comment.

2. Remote:

Members of the public who wish to provide public comment remotely, can log in using the
meeting ID provided above, or opening your <u>meeting app or accessing the web browser</u>
and entering the Meeting ID shown above after 7:45 am, at which time you will be muted and
added to the meeting.

General Public Comment:

- Members of the public can speak to any item that is NOT an ordinance on the regular agenda.
- Remote Individuals who wish to speak are asked to <u>register online at lovgov.org/CouncilPublicComment</u> by 5pm the day before the meeting. The Chair will call on people to comment in the order the registrations were received. This will follow in-person comment. Online registration is only required for the General Public Comment portion of the meeting.
- To speak to an agenda item when public comment is called for, please choose the raise your hand feature on the application. The moderator will then individually unmute the speaker and the speaker will need to follow the moderator's instructions before making comment. This will include turning on video. Each person will have three minutes to speak. The line will be muted at the end of the three minutes. Public comment is limited to residents of Larimer County, and individuals who own property or have business interests in the City.
- Individuals who wish to speak remotely but did not register <u>may</u> have a chance to comment once all in-person and online speakers who have registered are called on, if there is any time remaining. General Public Comment is limited to 60-minutes.

Regular Agenda Items:

- No online registration is required for individuals wanting to provide public comment on items included on the Regular Agenda.
- If an individual comments on a Resolution item shown on the Regular Agenda during General Public Comment, no additional comment can be given once the item comes up for discussion

on the Regular Agenda.

- Once a motion is made on an item shown on the Regular Agenda, the Chair will ask for public comment. The Chair will invite speakers to comment at that time. In-person comment will occur first, followed by online public comment.
